

FAQ's on Title Vehicles

TITLES MAY TAKE 30 DAYS OR LONGER TO PROCESS

Most of the cars, trucks, boats, and titled vehicles that ByceAUCTION sell are estate vehicles. This means they are usually titled in a decedent's name. We usually display a copy of the title.

Once the high bidder is established and the vehicle has been paid in full, it is suggested that the buyer take the receipt to the license bureau and obtain a temporary tag (usually 30 days, but might be available for longer)

The receipt and the title will be provided to the court with a request for Affidavit of transfer. THIS PROCESS MAY TAKE 30 DAYS OR LONGER.

Once the court issues the Affidavit, the title will be mailed to the Buyer. THIS AFFIDAVIT IS THE ONLY WAY TO TRANSFER THE TITLE OUT OF THE DECEDENT'S NAME, INTO THE NEW BUYER'S NAME.

The Buyer should take the title and affidavit to the state BMV where a new title will be issued. Once in possession of transferred title, the Buyer will likely take the title and receipt to the local license bureau to pay sales tax and obtain registration and plates for the vehicle.
